

ORDINANCE NO. 22-893

AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MUSCO LIGHT-STRUCTURE SYSTEM FOR THE CLARKSVILLE SOCCER COMPLEX IN THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, desires to purchase a Musco Light-Structure System for the Clarksville Soccer Complex in Clarksville, AR.

WHEREAS, the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible; and


WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated Sections 14-58-303(b)(1)(B) and 14-58-104 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the city of Clarksville, Arkansas:

- SECTION 1. The City hereby finds that competitive bidding is neither feasible nor practical in the current circumstance of the purchase of the above referenced light-structure system.
- SECTION 2. Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated Sections 14-58-303(b)(1)(B) and 14-58-104, the City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the purchase of a light-structure system.
- SECTION 3. The City hereby approves the expenditure not to exceed \$297,897.00 from the Series 2021 Sales and Use Tax Capital Improvement & Refund Bonds, payable to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC for the Light-Structure System for the Clarksville Soccer Complex in the City of Clarksville.
- SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.
- SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance being necessary for the prompt purchase of lighting for the Clarksville Soccer Complex because competitive bidding is not feasible or practical in this situation and for the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of Clarksville, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
