A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF
CLARKSVILLE TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID RECREATIONAL TRAILS
PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS City of Clarksville understand Federal-aid Recreational Trails Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match/in kind labor to develop or improve Clarksville Trail Entry Restoration & Restrooms, and

WHEREAS City of Clarksville understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Clarksville Council, that:
