

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, ARKANSAS HELD IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF CITY HALL ON MARCH 28, 2016 AT 12:00 P.M.

NEW BUSINESS

An Ordinance waiving competitive bidding requirements in connection with the reconstruction of Ridgewood for the Clarksville Street Department

Mayor Simpson introduced an Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE RECONSTRUCTION OF RIDGEWOOD FOR THE CLARKSVILLE STREET DEPARTMENT. The clerk read the Ordinance in its entirety. The Mayor declared the Ordinance open for discussion. City Engineer Morgan Barrett stated that Blackstone Construction had started the repaving process on Ridgewood. Upon milling the old pavement it was discovered that the base had failed. Mr. Barrett stated that Bowden Specialties has a machine for the soil cement reconstruction process that needed to be performed on Ridgewood in order to create a base for the asphalt. The estimated cost to do Ridgewood would be \$45,000.00. The process would begin on Thursday and should be completed on Friday so that the repaving could be completed on Monday. Alderman Schneider made a motion to approve the Ordinance which Alderman Bradley seconded. On the clerk's calling the roll, the following vote was recorded:

Ordinance No. 16-760 passed 5-0.

Alderman Wish made a motion to approve the emergency clause which Alderman Kluthe seconded.

City Engineer Morgan Barrett stated that Planning and Zoning Commission had approved the Drake Estates Subdivision at the March 24th meeting. Alderman King made a motion to approve the Ordinance which Alderman Schneider seconded. On the clerk's calling the roll, the following vote was recorded:

Ordinance No. 16-761 passed 5-0.

Alderman Schneider made a motion to approve the emergency clause which Alderman Bradley seconded.



Alston Youth Center Committee


