

Ordinance No. 16-757

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS, CURBS, AND DROP INLETS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to construct sidewalks, curbs, and drop inlets on Cherry Street from Brown Street to Railroad Street in order to promote safe vehicular, foot, and bike traffic; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.), Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the completion of this project will be beyond the \$20,000.00 state and city bid limit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has further determined that Holland Construction began construction of sidewalks, curbs, and drop inlets for the project and in order to sustain cohesiveness, will be retained to complete the project.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.), The City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the construction of sidewalks, curbs, and drop inlets along Cherry Street from Brown to Railroad Street.
- Section 2.** The City hereby approves the expenditure of \$25,000.00 payable to Holland Construction.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance being necessary for the effective operation of the City of Clarksville and for the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Clarksville, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
