

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE RECONSTRUCTION OF RIDGEWOOD FOR THE CLARKSVILLE STREET DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to reconstruct Ridgewood for the Street Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.), section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

WHEREAS, THE City Council has determined that Bowden Specialties, Inc. can provide this construction to meet the current needs of the Street Department; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has further determined that this is necessary for this work to be completed as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.), The City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the reconstruction of Ridgewood for the Clarksville Street Department.
- Section 2.** The City hereby approves the expenditure of \$45,000.00 payable to Bowden Specialities, Inc. for the soil cement reconstruction of Ridgewood to be paid from the Street Improvement Fund.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.


