Clark Road Bids

Mayor Simpson presented the bids for the Clark Road Construction Project. City Engineer Morgan stated the project would include a round-about at Cline and Clark and would be over a 2 year period. Alderman Weaver made a motion to accept the bid from Bowden at \$2,932,374.50 which Alderman Bradley seconded.

Alderman Wish abstained.

Motion passed 4-0 with one abstention.

Ordinance Waiving Competitive Bidding Requirements in connection with the purchase of materials for utility relocation for the Clark Road Project

Mayor Simpson introduced an Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS FOR UTILITY RELOCATION FOR THE CLARK ROAD PROJECT. The Clerk read the Ordinance. The Mayor declared the Ordinance open for discussion. Alderman King made a motion to approve the Ordinance which Alderman Weaver seconded.

Alderman Wish abstained.

Alderman King then made a motion to approve the emergency clause which Alderman Bradley seconded.

Alderman Wish abstained.

Ordinance No. 17-778 passed 4-0 with one abstention.

Ordinance Waiving Competitive Bidding Requirements in connection with the purchase of Property in the 100 Block of West Main Street.



Ordinance No. 17-779 passed 5-0.


It was discussed to have a joint meeting with CREDO on June 20th at 5:30 p.m. on Economic Development.
