Ordinance No. 19-825

AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO WHELEN OMNI DIRECTIONAL SIRENS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, is desirous of purchasing Two Whelen Omni Directional Sirens and associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.), Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1. Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.), the City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the purchase of precision approach path indicator lighting equipment.
- Section 2. The City hereby approves the expenditure not to exceed \$60,000 from city reserve funds payable to SafetyCom, Inc. for the purchase of Two Whelen Omni Directional Sirens and associated equipment.
- Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance being necessary for the effective operation of the City of Clarksville and for the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Clarksville, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
