

Ordinance No. 19-827

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF A VAC-TRON MACHINE FOR THE CLARKSVILLE STREET DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to purchase a Vac-Tron machine for the Street Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.) Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the purchase of a used Vac-Tron machine is more economical than purchasing a new machine; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has further determined that it is not feasible to request bids for used equipment.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.) The City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the purchase of a 2012 Vac-Tron Machine by Vermeer.
- Section 2.** The City hereby approves the expenditure of \$22,000.00 for the purchase of a 2012 Vac-Tron machine payable from reserve Street funds to JM Motors and adjusts the 2019 Budget to reflect this expenditure.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance being necessary for the effective operation of the Clarksville Street Department and for the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Clarksville, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.


