

Ordinance No. 19-834

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF A 2020 CHEVROLET TAHOE FOR THE CLARKSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to purchase a 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.) Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

WHEREAS, Superior Auto Group is the only vendor that has the 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 2WD 4 door commercial vehicle available for purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is not reasonable to pursue the normal bid process considering the availability is limited to one vendor;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.) The City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirements in connection with the purchase of a 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe.
- Section 2.** The City hereby approves the expenditure of \$34,533.64 for the purchase of a 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe and adjusts the 2019 General Fund Budget to reflect this expenditure.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance being necessary for the effective operation of the Clarksville Police Department and for the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Clarksville, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
