ORDINANCE NO. 21-863

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING AN OFFICER WITH THE CLARKSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE CERTAIN RETIREMENT ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Clarksville desires to allow its police officers retiring in good standing to make elections with regards to retirement insurance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1. Any Clarksville Police Department (CPD) officer who retires in good standing shall be deemed to be retired for the purposes of CPD employee health insurance, even if such employee makes an affirmative election to join the CPD auxiliary program.
- Section 2. For any CPD officer who makes such an election to join the CPD auxiliary program, the City will pay the officer's health insurance coverage premium as though the officer was a full time employee with the CPD.
- Section 3. After such time the CPD officer is no longer part of the auxiliary officer program, the officer shall still be deemed to be a retired officer and may still maintain eligibility to be enrolled in the CPD employee health insurance plan as such, however, the officer shall then be responsible for the cost of the health insurance premiums previously paid by the CPD.
