

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH FURNISHING OF LABOR, MATERIAL, AND EQUIPMENT TO PAINT THE INTERIOR OF THE MARVIN L. VINSON (MLV) MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to make certain improvements to the MLV Multi-Purpose Building; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.), Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible; and

**WHEREAS**, the city advertised for bids to paint the interior of the MLV Multi-Purpose Building and no bids were received; and

**WHEREAS**, the City then requested and received estimates from Cantrell Painting for costs associated with completion of this work; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed these estimates and found them to be wholly acceptable.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.), The City Council waives competitive bidding requirements in connection with the interior painting of the MLV Multi-Purpose Building and approves the expenditure of \$36,350.00 payable to Cantrell Painting.
- Section 2.** The City Council does hereby adjust the budget to reflect this expenditure from reserve funds.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.


