

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS FOR UTILITY RELOCATION FOR THE CLARK ROAD PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Arkansas, recognizes the need to make improvements to Clark Road to better serve the Clarksville School District and to improve traffic flow; and

**WHEREAS**, the planned improvements to Clark Road requires the relocation of utilities by Clarksville Light and Water; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that proceeding with the bid process for materials necessary for the utility relocation is not feasible due to the time constraints in letting the bid for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. # 2011 Supp.), Section 14-58-303 to waive competitive bidding requirements in situations where such process is not practical or feasible.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Clarksville, Arkansas that:

- Section 1.** Under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (1998 Repl. & 2011 Supp.), The City does hereby waive competitive bidding requirement for the purchase of materials for the relocation of utilities for the Clark Road Project.
- Section 2.** The City hereby approves the expenditure of \$85,680.00 payable to Nassau National Cable for purchase of material to relocate electric lines and the expenditure of \$68,690.70 to Winwater for the purchase of material to relocate water lines for the Clark Road Project.
- Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.


